Pool Rental Rules

(Initial each rule)

Pool Rental

2. Deposit: A deposit equal to ½ of the amount due is to be paid when reservation is made & form signed. Balance is due prior to the start of your event.
3. Facility Walk-Thru: A walk thru with the Wellness Center Manager or appointed representative should be conducted before and after the event. Note anything you see in the room that you do not want to be held responsible for prior to use and answer any questions you might have.
General Rules for a Pool Rental
1. Food and Drink: Food and drink (other than water) is not allowed in the pool area. If you would like to have a meal or food with your event, the multi-purpose room upstairs in the Wellness Center is available to rent for \$25/hr. upon availability.
2. Smoking and Tobacco: The use of any tobacco products is strictly prohibited on any Hopedale Medical Complex properties. This includes vaping.
3. Alcohol: Absolutely No alcoholic beverages allowed on the premises.
4. Lifeguards: There is not a lifeguard onsite. Swim at your own risk. The pool is under video surveillance and our staff is trained in CPR/AED. Additionally, our staff would initiate the emergency action plan for the pool in the event of an incident.
5. Attendees: You are responsible for all individuals attending your event. Additionally, we will need a written roster of all individuals in attendance. All individuals of the party that are not members of the Wellness center will need to sign a separate waiver. If the attendee is under 18 years of age, a parent/guardian will be required to sign waiver before entrance will be permitted.
6. Behavior: This is a family facility therefore foul language, inappropriate conversation any oublic display of affection, indecent exposure or inappropriate swimwear such as speedo-type or string bikini will not be tolerated by anyone in the party and will be asked to leave the premises.

____1. Cost of Pool Rental: You are allowed to rent the facility by the hour. This this cost is \$90/hr.

7. General Facility Etiquette: Immediately notify the Manager of the Wellness Center regarding any thing that may have gotten broken, stained, or misused. Additionally, all trash and unused items are to be disposed of at the end of your event.
8. Locker Room Use: If you have children over the age of five that are of the opposite gender than the parent, the private locker room must be used. The main locker rooms are male/female use only.
Pool Room Rules
1. Hygiene: All swimmers are asked to shower before entering the pool.
2. Pool Deck: No street shoes allowed by any person who will be on the deck of the pool. Additionally, there is ABSOLUTLEY no running on the pool deck.
3. Behavior: Roughhousing or dunking is not permitted in either pool. Additionally, spitting or blowing your nose in the pool is prohibited.
4. Diving/Cannonballs: ABSOLUTLEY no diving or doing "cannonballs" off the edge of the bool or stairs is not allowed.
5. Stairs/Wheelchair Ramps: These areas are for entry and exit of the pools and should not be a gathering spot or a location to jump off.
6. Swim Attire: Appropriate swim wear must be worn. Speedos and thong bikinis are not appropriate swim attire. Absolutely no street clothes are to be worn in the pool.
7. Diapers: Children not fully potty-trained must be wearing a swim diaper. Children cannot be changed on the pool deck. Diaper and clothes changing needs to take place in the locker room.
8. Supervision: 8 years or younger - Supervision is required by an adult in the water or pool side within an arm's reach. Direct supervision is permitted with the use of a life jacket.
9. Pool Toys Accepted: small water toys, balls, dive sticks, rings, snorkels, masks, fins, and noodles. Water aerobics barbells, kickboards and belts included if used properly.
10. Large Pool Toys: Any large pool toy such as a lounger, raft or any type of blow-up must be approved by the Wellness Center Manager prior to use.
11. Items From Home: Any item such as a life jacket, toys, etc. must be thoroughly cleaned with soap and water before they can enter the pools at the Wellness Center.

These rules are in place to ensure a safe and enjoyable envir pool area. The Hopedale Wellness Center has the authority to violates any of these rules.	•
